The Center for Teaching and Learning has provided the following tips for tracking disengaged students:

1. Crowdsource their classmates: Students are often in contact with each other across a variety of platforms. Simply ask students to let you know if they know of classmates who are missing or otherwise not engaging, using whatever means you are using to teach your class (LMS, Email, etc.)
2. Blackboard: Faculty can use the Performance Dashboard, which lists the date of the last access: https://help.blackboard.com/Learn/Instructor/Performance/Performance_Dashboard
3. Canvas: Canvas analytics provides participation information <https://community.canvaslms.com/docs/DOC-18531-what-is-new-analytics>
